Take Our Kids to Work Day is an annual event that encourages grade nine students to spend a day with their parent, guardian, or other relative/family friend at their worksite. It is an opportunity for students to develop an appreciation for the importance of staying in school, gaining exposure to skills required in today's workplace, developing an appreciation for parents' roles in making a living, and explore career options in a practical way. The TOKW program helps students connect school, the world of work, and potential career opportunities.

The teachers at Sir John A. Macdonald would strongly encourage all Grade nine students to participate in this rewarding educational experience. If it is not possible for students to go to their parent/guardian's workplace, parents may make arrangements so that their son/daughter can participate with another parent/guardian.

What you need to know: We support your student's participation in this event, <u>however it is</u> <u>not a CBE-sponsored event</u>. This means that parents/guardians need to communicate with the school to arrange an **excused** absence for the day.

Students who choose not to participate are expected to attend school. They will be working on an alternate career exploration-based task.
