AGENCY REFERRAL

Social Worker/Agency refer Families they are actively participating in programming with. Families must meet the Low Income Cut Off (pre-tax) criteria.

Restrictions:

- Single adult applicants or families with adults only are not eligible
- Client cannot be receiving a hamper from any other source
- Client may only receive a hamper from this program once every 3 years. (Eligible again on the fourth year)

Referrals open from October until one week before Christmas (exceptions can be made).

Eligibility – Families with at least one child aged 1+ living in the home.

Application Process – A Social Worker referral is required from an agency where the applicant is actively involved with agency programming.
